

The Mission was established in 1901. In 1925, the Mission became the Calgary Chinese United Church. It was one of the first Chinese congregations of The United Church of Canada. The original Chinese Mission was built in 1910. It was located at 120- 2nd Ave. SW It had a tennis court with a high fence on the west side. It was founded by Mr. Thomas Underwood, Mayor of Calgary.
