On the 100-year anniversary of the Chinese Immigration Act of 1923, we remember the perseverance of the Chinese community's ancestors in overcoming historic exclusion and discrimination in our country. Whereas: Also known as the Chinese Exclusion Act, the Act

commenced on July 1, 1923, prohibiting Chinese immigration to Canada for nearly 24 years, until its repeal

on May 14, 1947;

Whereas: When the Act came into effect, the day became known as

"Humiliation Day" to Chinese Canadians;

Whereas: Calgarians celebrate the immeasurable contributions of

Chinese Canadians to our city, whose culture is part of the historic multicultural fabric and ethno-cultural vibrancy that

enriches Calgary as a community.
