## The Mission

The Chinese Mission was not only a building, but the foundation of Chinese Community.

It held events for wartime fundraisers for refugees, musical concerts, and meeting place for the people. The young and old would go to the Mission for their own reasons such as English classes, sharing of stories, or perhaps for nourishment.
